Twenty minutes after landing at the airport, I can be sitting at the bar at **Blackbird**, warming up by the wood-fired pizza oven and enjoying the best *burrata* outside of Milan. The **Lark** motel is my stay of choice and has great design, a late-night taco truck, and free trail mix in the lobby. Coffee at **Treeline** or **Ghost Town** is the perfect stop on your

way to **Bridger Bowl** ski resort, thirty minutes away. While I am known to survive on espresso alone, **Lot G Cafe** in the Cannery District and **Wild Crumb** bakery have the best breakfasts in town. If my muscles are sore, I head to **Chico Hot Springs** and grab a burger and a local MAP Brewing IPA at the bar.
