## Okii Sato

The founder of Tokyo design studio Nendo created *50 Manga Chairs*, an intriguing installation that explored the Japanese tradition of manga — comic books created through a series of black-and-white illustrations. Translating the symbolic nature of manga to furniture, the chairs created a grid resembling manga frames on a sheet of paper. “Manga currently has a strong influence in the art world in terms of pop culture,” says Sato. “It expresses feelings and movement through simple black lines and black ink. I wanted to transfer the two-dimensional back into three-dimensional.” The installation, which debuted in Milan, will show at New York’s Friedman Benda gallery in September.
